



Quality Statement

Product Longevity

Duty Free Terps (DFT) asserts that a definitive shelf life for our products has not been established. As noted in our Product Specification Sheets, we recommend storing all products sealed, cold, and protected from light. Products are flushed with inert gas prior to shipment; after opening, if you plan to store the remaining material for later use, we advise refilling the headspace with inert gas.

When stored under the recommended conditions, our oils can maintain their quality for at least three years. Use of the product beyond three years from the born-on date (BoD) printed on the label, which represents the date samples were taken for third-party COA testing, does not constitute expiration. However, as a voluntary quality assurance measure, we suggest retesting the material to evaluate for out-of-spec compounds and/or residual solvents. A qualitative inspection for abnormal consistency or thickening, moisture, discoloration, and/or off-notes in aroma is also advised.

Minor compositional changes or gradual degradation may occur over time, as essential oils are complex mixtures of naturally derived substances. As stated in our Product Specification Sheets, DFT maintains that batch-to-batch variation for the five most abundant compounds in each product will remain within the specified ranges.

This statement is provided without the intention of preempting or superseding any regulatory requirements related to the use or incorporation of DFT products in downstream finished goods. We remain committed to maintaining safety standards and ensuring compliance with all applicable regulations.
